-> average 1':30" in-between 2 stations

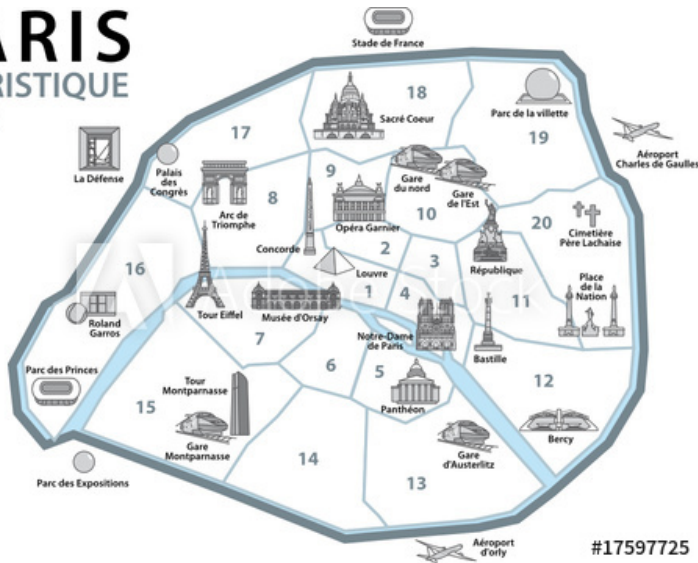

## PARIS TOURISTIQUE #2 gris



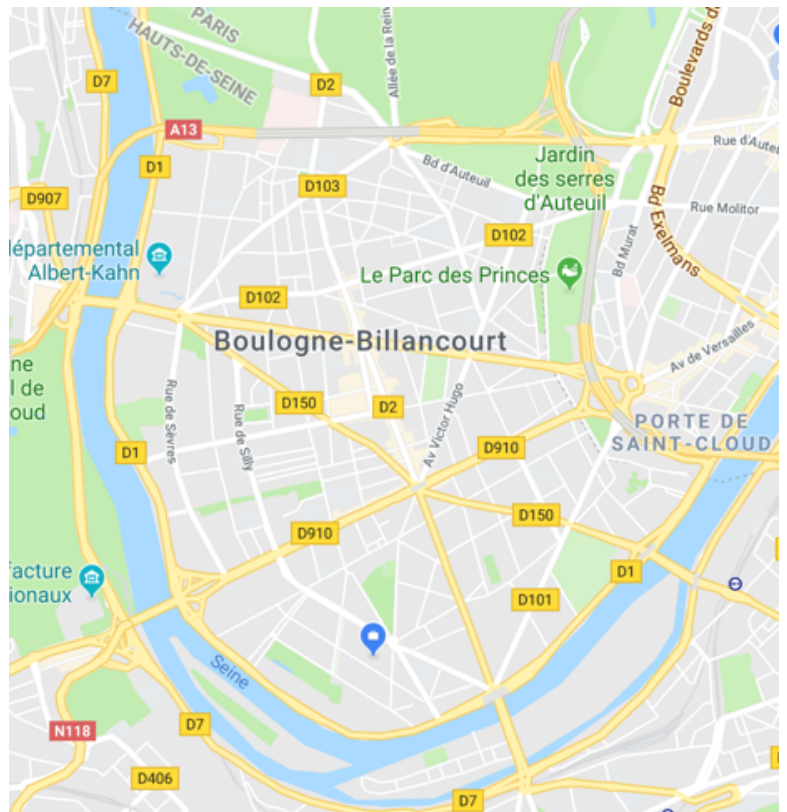
## BOULOGNE

**Departure :** All parisian Métro stations  
Use a standard Métro ticket

ligne 9 direction Pont de Sèvres or  
ligne 10 direction Porte de Saint Cloud

**Stop:** Following Greeter indications

At Paris gate, the largest city in Ile-de-France after Paris, Boulogne is a city rich in cultural treasures, such as the Albert Kahn Museum and its gardens, the museum of the 1930s; the houses or buildings of: Le Corbusier, Mallet Stevens, Perret, Fisher... A City whose traces can still tell the story of yesterday's life.



## RUEIL MALMAISON



### Departure:

Métro Stations: One of Nation - Chatelet - Auber - Etoile

Buy two way RER ticket for Rueil Malmaison around 5€)

Ligne RER A – Direction Saint Germain en Laye  
It takes around 30 minutes from Paris center

**Stop :** Rueil Malmaison – Take appointment with your greeter at Rueil RER station

Discover the small village of Rueil, which, despite its proximity to Paris and La Défense, has managed to preserve its former charm. Our greeters will help you discover the secret of the alleys and green parks

that once hosted famous characters... It seems that you can even meet the imperial couple Napoleon and Josephine there!

## SAINT GERMAIN

**Departure:** RER Métro Stations. One of: La Défense – Etoile – Auber – Gare de Lyon

Buy a two ways RER ticket for Saint Germain en Laye (around 5€)

Ligne RER A1 Direction: Boissy Saint Léger  
It takes around 30 minutes from Paris center.

**Stop :** Saint Germain en Laye RER Station.

Do you dream of a big breath of fresh air just a stone's throw from Paris? The Saint-Germain-en-Laye forest covers 3,500 hectares and will satisfy your desires. From Philippe-Auguste to Louis XIV, Saint-Germain-en-Laye was the resort of many kings of France, as well as famous writers, musicians and artists! Come and feel the pulse of the City.





## ISSY LES MOULINEAUX

**Departure :** Any one of Métro station  
Use a standard Métro ticket  
ligne 12 direction Mairie d'Issy

**Stop :** Mairie d'Issy. Organize appointment with your Greeter in front of Tourism Office

It is 9000 years of a history that begins with prehistoric man in the Issy plain, continues in the Middle Ages with the monks of Saint-Germain, reaches its peak in the seventeenth century with the presence of the greats of the Court, such as the famous "Queen Margot". The city is ideally located on the banks of the Seine.

## VERSAILLES

### Departure:

One of the following Métro station : Gare Austerlitz – Chatelet – Pont Alma – Javel

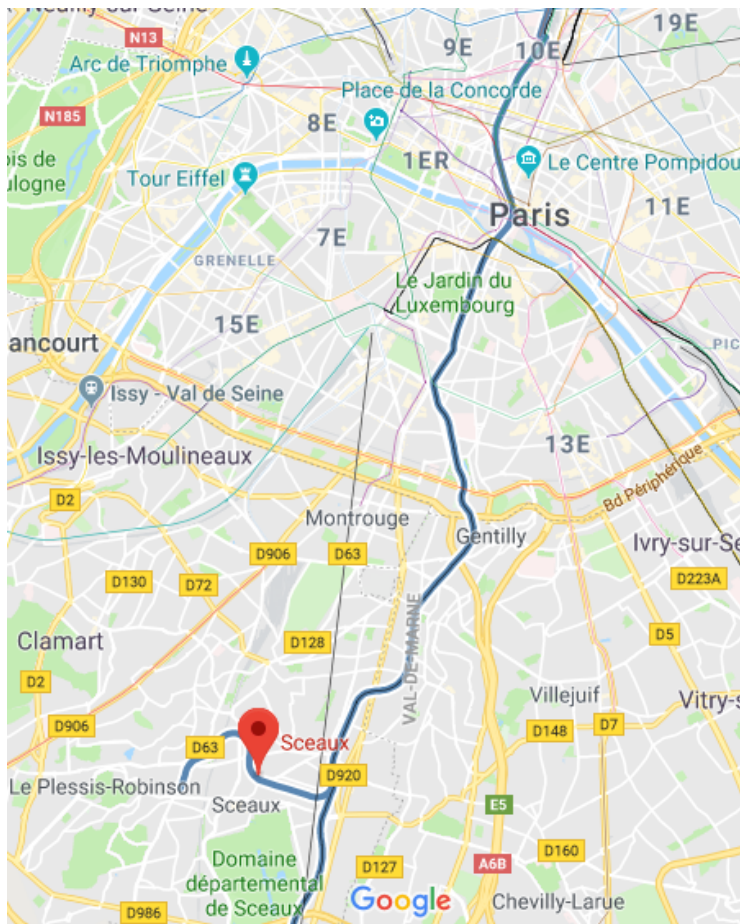
Buy a two ways RER ticket for Versailles Rive Gauche (around 5€)

Ligne RER C direction Versailles Rive Gauche  
It takes around 30 minutes from Paris center

**Stop :** Versailles Rive Gauche terminus

In the visitor's imagination, the name Versailles sparkles with gold and the magical reflections of the Hall of Mirrors. But what he does not always know is that the city around the castle was designed simultaneously to serve as a luxurious setting for the famous palace. Discover curiosities and anecdotes in the shade of the castle.





## SCEAUX

### Departure:

Métro Stations of your choice: Gare du Nord – Chatelet – Luxembourg – Denfert Rochereau

Buy a two ways ticket to Sceaux or Bourg la Reine (around 5€)

RER B line direction Plessis-Robinson

Timing: 15 to 20 minutes from Denfert-Rochereau.

**Stop :** Bourg la Reine or Sceaux following your Greeter appointment.

Located about 5 km south of Paris, Sceaux boasts one of the largest green spaces of the Greater Paris metropolis. The Parc de Sceaux gardens, designed in the same era as the gardens of Versailles, the rue Houdan, with its renowned culinary

specialities, and a rich cultural offering make Sceaux a particularly popular town with tourists and day-trippers
